Achieve Better Results For Your State

The most innovative governors across the country have learned the secret power of using data and evidence to inform their decision-making. These

governors have shown that implementing evidence-based practices, such as those highlighted by **Results for America's** 2018 Invest in What Works State Standard of Excellence, gets better results for their residents. From cost-benefit analysis and data sharing to the



use of evidence in grantmaking,

these governors have made progress on their most important goals, including improving the health and safety of their residents, saving money, boosting transparency, increasing efficiency, and enhancing revenue collection.

As highlighted in the 2018 State Standard of Excellence released at a July 2018 event cohosted by the National Governors Association, the Washington Department of Social and Health Services created an integrated database to track outcomes for its clients, and saved \$10 million by better coordinating care for high-risk Medicaid patients. Rhode Island's Department of Children, Youth, and Families moved to a results-driven procurement process, which helped reduce the number of children in group care by nearly 20 percent. Tennessee increased transparency by sharing strategic goals, statewide performance dashboards, and fiscal data via the Transparent TN website. Ohio improved government efficiency through *hundreds of individual projects* at dozens of state agencies that *reduced processing time* by an average of 67%.

In all these areas and more, the *2018 Invest in What Works State Standard of Excellence* provides a roadmap for how governors across the country can implement these best practices. In total, the standard contains 88 best practice examples for how state governments can consistently and effectively use data and evidence in budget, policy, and management decisions to achieve better outcomes for their residents.
