Position Requirements

RFA offers summer internships to individuals who are at least 18 years old and who have:

Rate of Pay

Individuals with 1-4 years of postsecondary education or relevant work experience in government or nonprofit organizations will be paid **\$27/hour.**

Individuals with 5 or more years of postsecondary education or relevant work experience in government or nonprofit organizations will be paid \$32/hour.

The exact work schedule will be determined in coordination with the relevant RFA program lead.

Interns at Results for America are 1099 employees and are not eligible for benefits.
